

Thirdmill Seminary co-hosted our first annual Bible Conference with partner, **Lifted Church Miami.** 

Presented in English with simultaneous translation in Spanish, 161 ministry leaders participated in the webinar "Interpreting and Teaching the Bible," both online and inperson at the church in Miami.

Carmen Brumley served as an excellent translator for our conference teachers, Drs. Richard Pratt and Greg Perry. Drs. Rich Ramsay and Jeff David led breakout groups to help participants put the principles of interpretation into practice. #### Continuing Educación Education Continua



Beginning in January 2022, Dr. Richard Ramsay has led our Spanish team in a new initiative of continuing education courses designed for those already in ministry.

Each class is designed to address practical ministry activities like evangelism and church planting, teaching and preaching, as well as cultural apologetics.

These classes arise from two aspects of our strategic plan:
1) continuing to develop new programs and resources to serve the church, and 2) practical workshops that go beyond our degree programs to partner with churches and their leaders. The response has been positive, with 40 new students participating in these courses.

Dr. Brumley has been significant in helping establish the foundation of the seminary as Compliance Officer for the last two years.

Dr. Brumley received his Ph.D. in Educational Administration from Southern Illinois University and his Masters in Ministry Leadership from Rockbridge Seminary. Bob has extensive experience as both a teacher and administrator, having served as the Academic Dean at Universidad FLET from 2007-2011 and continuing as Academic Dean at Laurel University from 2011-2014. When Laurel was acquired by Indiana Wesleyan University, Bob served as Director of the Global Academic Programs from 2014 to 2020. He has worked effectively teaching and training pastors both in person and through distance education methodology.

Residing in Miami, Florida, Bob also serves on staff at Lifted Church and can relate to bivocational ministry similar to many of our students. We are thankful for Bob's experience and his commitment to equipping students in their study of the Bible and in their commitment to growing the Kingdom of God.

## Site Visit Report

This summer brought a long awaited and worked-for day: hosting a site visit from our accrediting body. Delivering graduate level theological education is very much a TEAM EFFORT! It is not quite on the level of rocket science, but the work of our two language teams, English and Spanish, allows us to deliver quality theological education. The teams include **student services** to promote the seminary, receive and evaluate applications, publish handbooks and the catalog, keep our website updated, as well as bookkeeping. Our **academic team** of deans, core faculty, adjunct faculty, and our curriculum committee evaluate the work our students produce and the outcomes of their learning.

The Site Visit team evaluated all parts of our team to make sure we are 'ready for launch' as an accredited institution. Their report, like those of aerospace teams, always find ways to improve our systems, processes, and programs. This is one of the main reasons we want to be accredited, so we have outside accountability to keep growing as educators and pastors.

While it was an intense experience, it was also valuable. The report produced by the Site Team will be used, along with our response and changes, when the commission meets in January 2023 to act on our application for accreditation. Please keep praying with us as we work towards this BIG GOAL!
