

Letter from the President



Dear friends of Thridmill Seminary,

Paul the Apostle described the church as growing up and strengthening when every ligament, joint, muscle, bone, and organ of the Body of Christ does its part! This year has been a year of growth as God has sent more gifted students, staff, and faculty into our learning community. Our part in Christ's Body is primarily to teach God's Word to those the Holy Spirit has called and gifted to teach, pastor, and disciple others. We do this through a unique partnership between our credentialed faculty and local leaders in many parts of Christ's global church.

This year, we grew in several ways. This past Spring, **Dr. Chris Hatch** and I traveled to East Africa where he taught the Gospels and I taught the Book of Acts in northern Tanzania. Chris also traveled to visit several of our students in Burundi. We both visited Nairobi, where we established a new learning hub in partnership with two churches. Soon after, I also traveled to South America where we joined partners in Buenos Aires to launch a new course on vocational discipleship. How do pastors disciple their congregants to understand that *their calling into the workplace is also a calling to serve the Lord of all?* In this case, the course was written in Spanish first, then translated into English.

However, that was only one of many new courses that were developed, launched, and approved by our accreditors in a new degree program—the Master of Divinity degree.

The MDIV degree, or its courses in Bible, Theology, Church History, and Ministry Skills, is required by some denominations for those who are ordained to pastor churches. With new courses in preaching, counseling, apologetics, Greek and Hebrew for exegesis, we see increased opportunity to serve the church and those preparing for ordination.

Our annual conference and graduation this September featured the gifted teaching of **Dr. Richard Pratt**, the founder and President of our parent organization, Third Millennium Ministries, Inc., on the Book of Chronicles.

We also recognized and celebrated the gifts, hard work, and sacrifices of our graduates. Please join us in praying for them (pictured at right).

As Paul reminded the Corinthian church, we might have a part in planting or watering but *it is God who causes his churches to grow*. Please join us in thanking God for this year of growth in partnerships, degree programs, and students. Also keep us on your prayer list that we might be faithful stewards who stay curious and open to the new ways that God will lead us to new fields of growth and harvest.






What makes Thirdmill Seminary unique?

We've designed an innovative approach to theological education at Thirdmill Seminary with co-vocational church leaders in mind, because most of our students work another job to support their family while they serve Christ and the local church.

Our field-based training approach includes an alternating schedule. Within each 8-week course students meet every other week with credentialed faculty and other students from different parts of the global church. On the alternate weeks, students focus on their personal discipleship and strengthening their ministry skills as they meet with local mentor-coaches who know them and their context.




