We are excited to announce that our accreditors have approved two new degree options for Christian leaders, *the Master of Divinity* in English and *Maestría de divinidad en español*.

The 84-credit MDIV builds on the 52-credit Master of Arts in Christian Studies. Thirdmill Seminary continues its unique partnership between our credentialed faculty in the global classroom and local ministry coaches. Though the MDIV is designed for those who are called to lead local congregations as pastors or church planters, we remain focused on training missionary leaders for missionary churches.

You may have noticed we have a new logo and a new website (launching soon): thirdmillseminary.edu. The shield communicates our strong commitment to Scripture and the apostolic faith. The bridge with its three columns signals our mission to span barriers to a high value theological education that focuses on three primary tasks of ministry: interpreting Scripture together; doing theology in context; and forming disciples in community.

The Master of Divinity

Thirdmill Seminary offers a high value theological education that focuses on three primary tasks of ministry: interpreting Scripture together; doing theology in context; and forming disciples in community. Our Graduate Certificate program (18 credits) offers an introduction to biblical studies and underscores interpreting Scripture together. Our Master of Arts and Master of Divinity programs build on this foundation, offering a deeper and wider engagement with Scripture. Our Master of Arts in Christian Studies (52 credits) emphasizes the apostolic faith and doing theology in context.

The Master of Divinity program (84 credits) is designed for those who are called to plant and lead local churches and offers a balance of courses in all three tasks of ministry. In addition to core requirements in the Bible, theology, and ministry practices, the MDIV allows students to choose electives courses in areas of interest and/or requirements of their ecclesiastical bodies.

The Master of Divinity requires 35 credits in Interpreting Scripture Together, 31 credits in Doing Theology in Context and 18 credits in Forming Disciples in Community, for a total of 84 credits.

Most of our students are co-vocational and take only one or two courses per term. Since we have five 8-week terms each academic year, it takes co-vocational students approximately 4 years to complete the MACS and 6 years to complete the MDIV. Students who can devote more time, taking 2 or 3 courses per term, can complete an MACS in 2 years and an MDIV in 3 years.
